

ROLE OF THE BUDDY

Buddy's and Instructors will work collaboratively during Course 9 Consolidated Clinical Experience during the supervision process and communicate frequently about the student's progress. If it becomes apparent that intervention is needed, the lead instructor will provide additional help and guidance at the request of the Buddy.

Roles and Responsibilities:

- Act as a role model for the learner, by providing professional, ethical and person-centered care
- Act as a resource for the learner
- Observe and keep track of the learner's functioning and performance
- Assist the learner in achieving the necessary performance evaluation indicators
- Orient the learner to the practicum setting, including procedures and routines
- Assign the daily client workload to the learner
- To support the learner in reflecting on their daily experiences; daily reflective questions. These questions will help the learner identify their strengths, areas for improvement, and maintain organization throughout the day
- Supervise/assist with the assignment as required
- To provide professional, corrective, and timely feedback to the learner
- Initiate timely discussions with the learner regarding the learner's performance, if warranted
- Provide the learner with feedback on the learners' overall performance for their clinical evaluation
- Maintain open communication with the student and clinical instructor regarding student performance concerns

Buddy's are accountable to their employer and must work in partnership with the clinical instructor and educational institution. Concerns regarding student safety, conduct, or performance must be reported immediately
